


The 'Roadmap' is a practical exercise to help you focus on procedures that could cause 'severe' suffering(US Category E), identify contributing factors, and find ways of avoiding or refining these.

CULTURE

It is based around an 'audit' of procedures, by a team of people with different expertise and perspectives. This could be the AWERB, AWB, IACUC or AEC, or a group set up for the task including animal technologists, veterinarians and scientists. The approach takes account of three main causes of severe suffering: inherently severe procedures, cumulative severity, and mortality.
